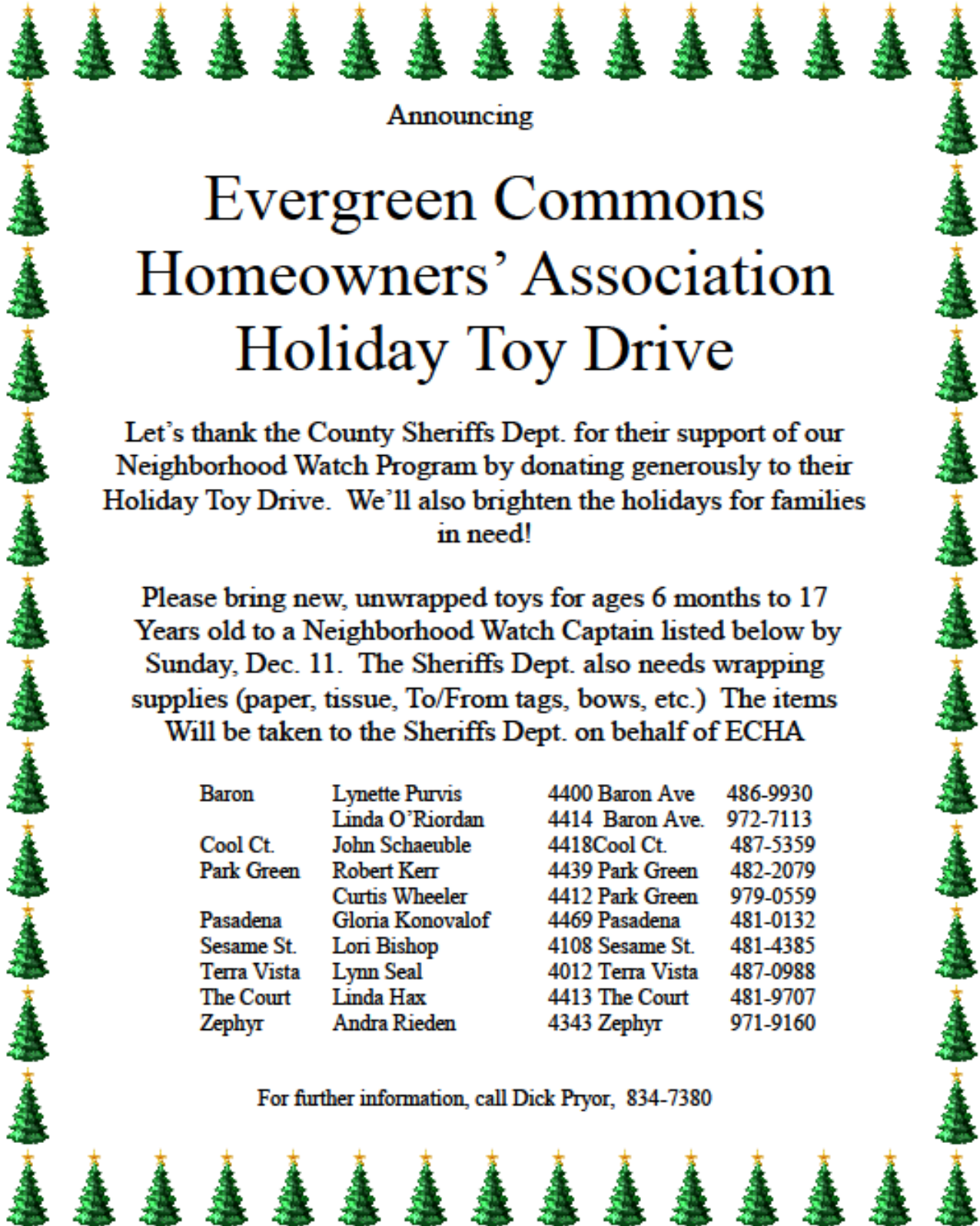

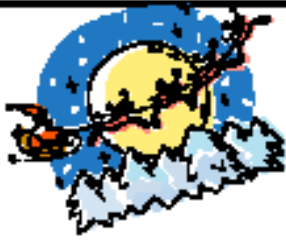
# Evergreen Commons Homeowners' Association Holiday Toy Drive
