The Sheriff’s Dept was notified and they were immediately on the scene! Just a reminder. Be vigilant!

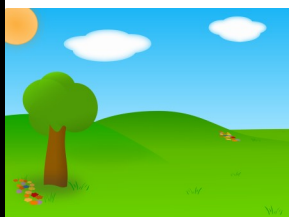
